<p>SUMMARY: Alcoholic Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA) Supervisory Investigator Mark Brashears determined that on Sunday, July 12, 2020, Residents, located at 1317 Connecticut Avenue N.W., Washington, D.C. was in violation of D.C. Official Code §25-823 (1) and (2), and DCMR §23-810. 2 (k) Specifically, the establishment failed to adhere to the Mayor's Emergency Order, by operating and allowing alcohol to be consumed on premise after 12:00 a.m. This determination was made by SI Brashears during monitoring for After-Hours violations.</p> <p>DETAILS: On Sunday, July 12, 2020, at approximately 1:00 a.m., SI Brashears, was conducting after-hours monitoring on 18th Street N.W., when he observed approximately 15 people seated on a Sidewalk Café consuming alcohol and eating food (Exhibits #1, #2, #3, #4, and #5). The Sidewalk Café was well illuminated. SI Brashears entered the establishment, and observed a waitress and bartender. SI Brashears was met at the bar by establishment owner, Radovan Jankovic.</p> <p>SI Brashears advised Mr. Jankovic, that under the Mayor's Emergency Order, the sale, service, and consumption of alcohol had to end at 12:00 a.m. Mr. Jankovic stated that he had already stopped serving food and alcohol, and that the patrons were being allowed to finish their food. Mr. Jankovic also stated that no one was currently consuming alcohol. SI Brashears pointed out that there were several patrons on the far end of the Sidewalk Café that had beer bottles in front of them on the table, and that it was an hour past closing time. Mr.</p>			

Jankovic stated that he understood, and agreed to close the establishment.
A review of Residents ABRA records revealed that the establishment does not have a Settlement Agreement or Security Plan.

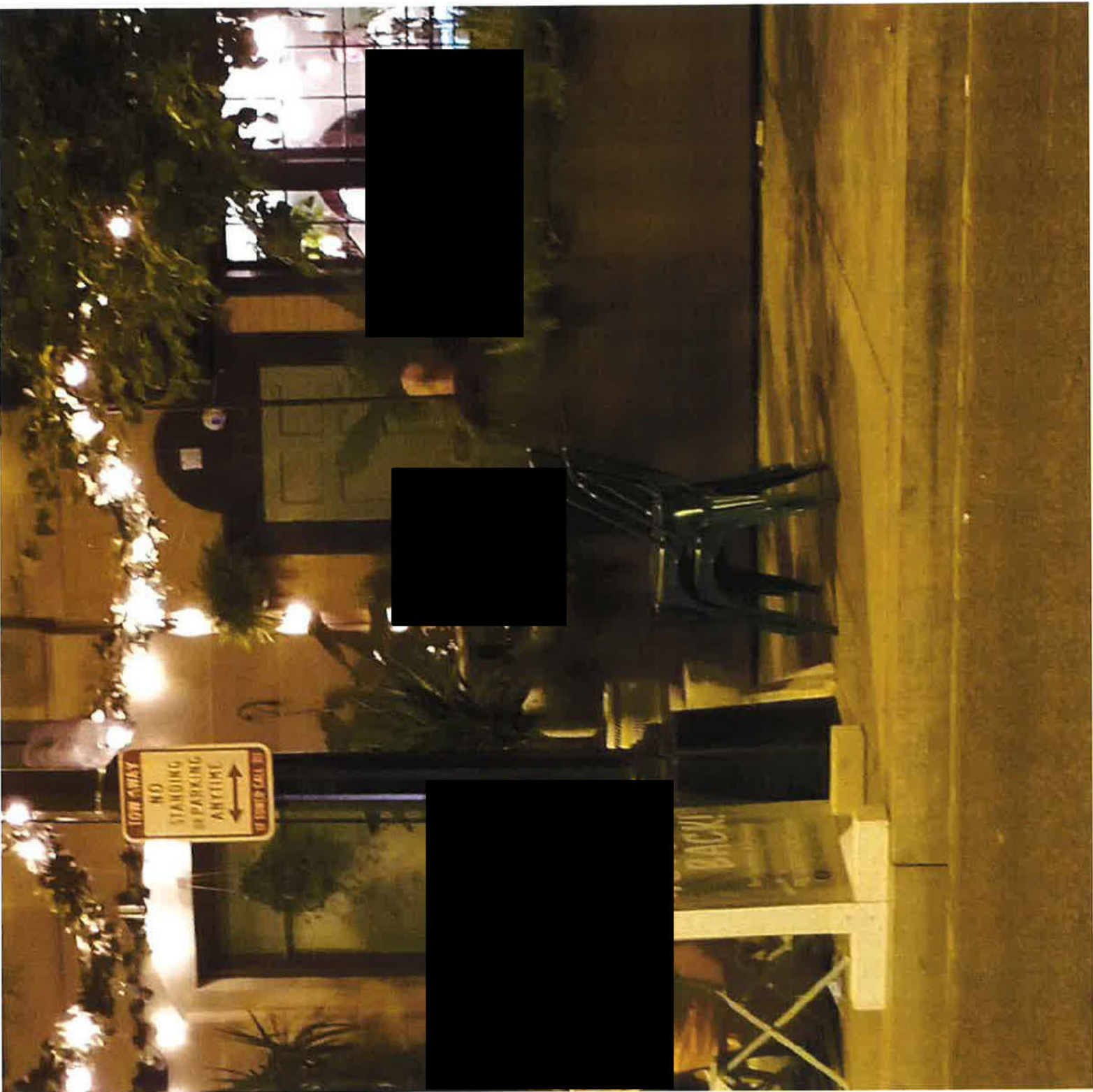

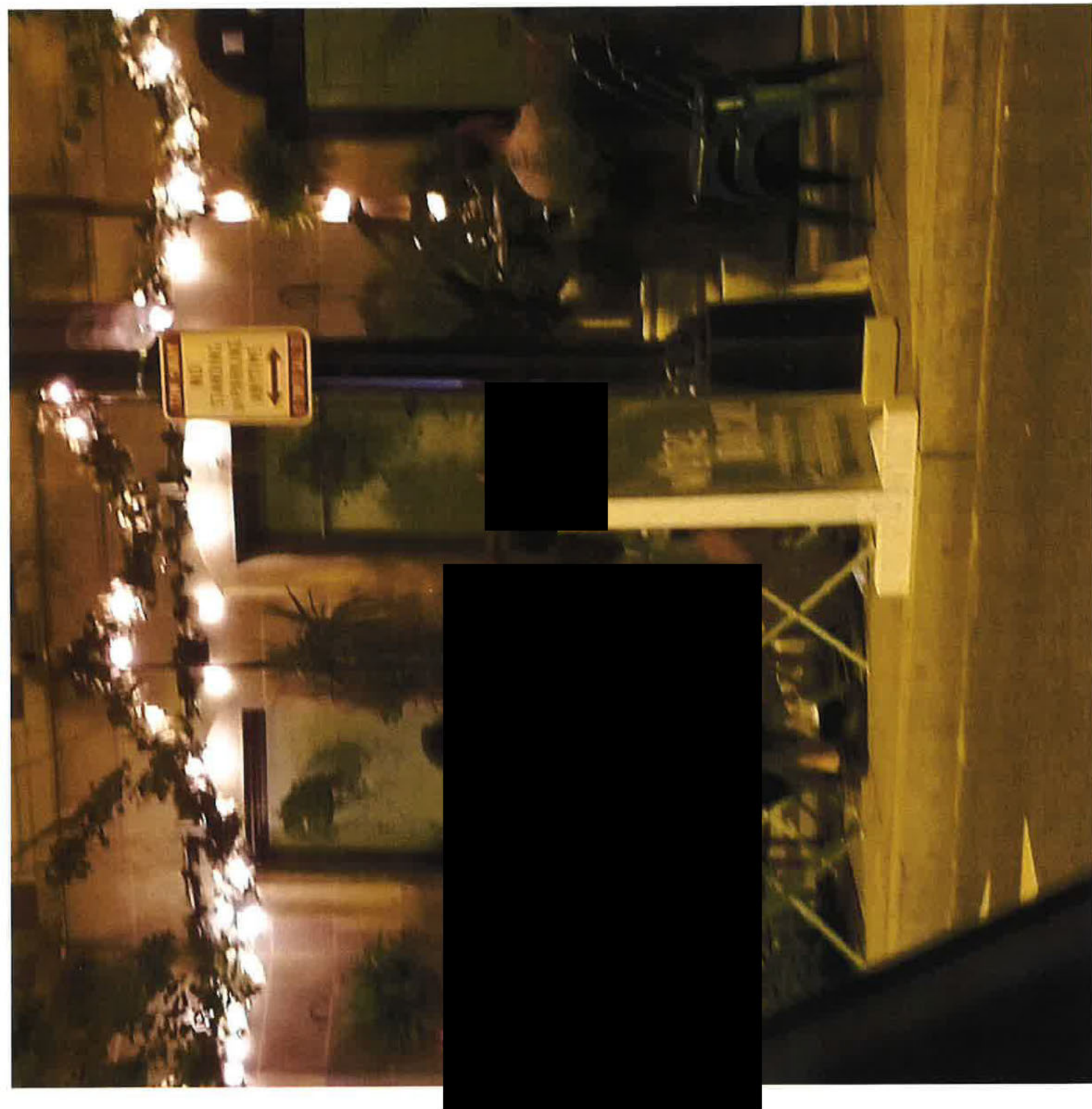

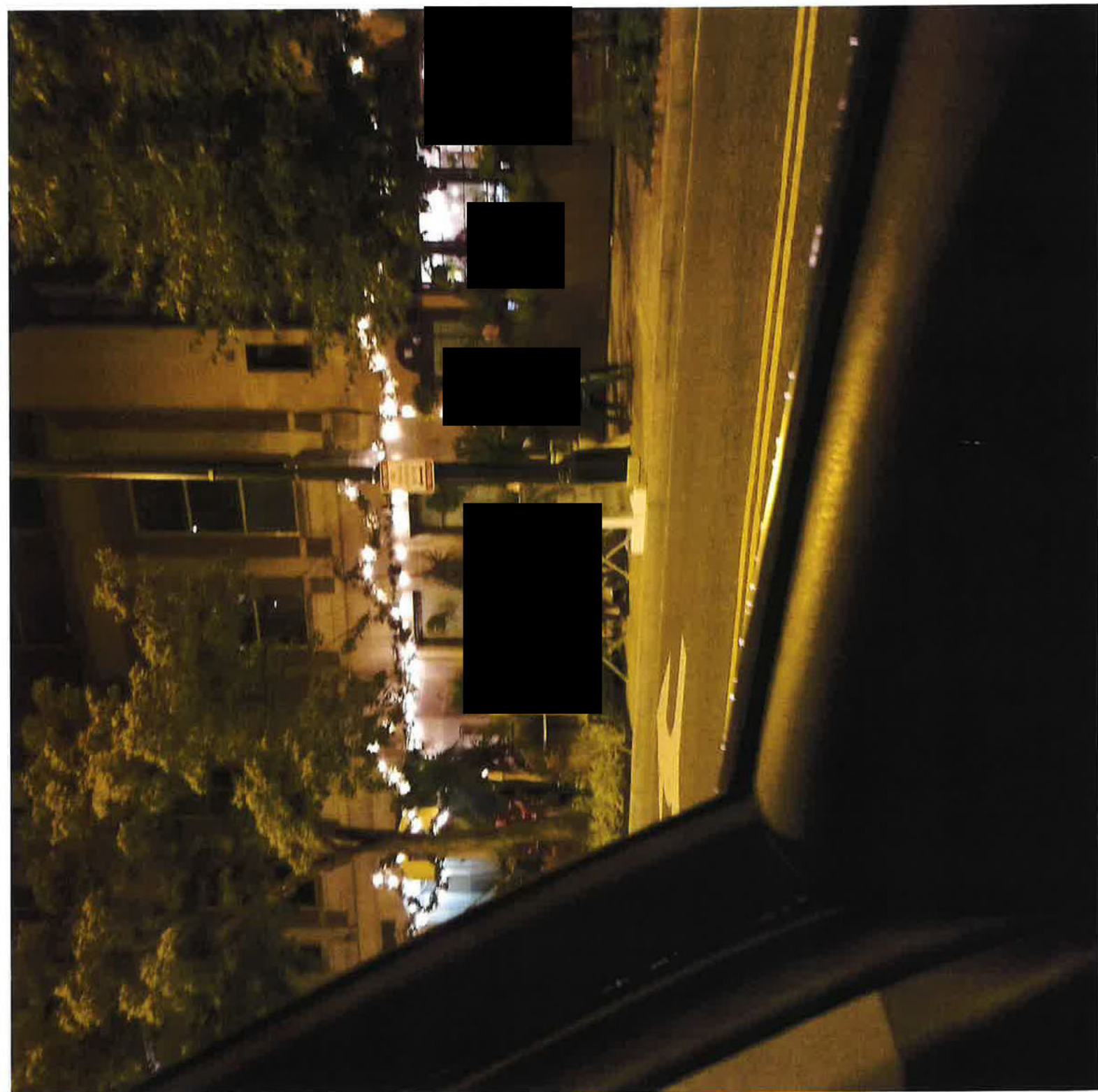
